Trespassers W: "the drugs we all need"
release date September 1st, 2005.

After a bit of delay, due to circumstances beyond our control, Somnimage is proud to present the new Trespassers W album on cd, titled 'The Drugs We All Need' (SOM 00013). The 17 tracks on this album were recorded by Camille Dings and mixed by Wim Oudijk. The Trespassers W line-up at the time of the recordings consisted of: Cor Gout (vocals),

Ronnie Krepel (guitar, keyboards), Witte van der Veen (guitar, samples), Marcel Nab (bass, guitar) Frans Friederich (trumpet) and Bart Vos (drums, percussion).

This new cd is part two of a trilogy called 'Sex & Drugs & Rock'n'roll', of which the first two volumes have been released by Somnimage ('Sex and the end of it' and 'The drugs we all need') and the third one (The noble folly of rock'n'roll') is going to be finished by the end of this summer.

Italian journalist Enrico Ramunni, who wrote a feature article on Trespassers W in Rockerilla 298 (june 2005), elicited a short explanation on the trilogy from singer and lyricist Cor Gout.

(er.): After the chapter on Sex, your new album of the planned trilogy deals with Drugs, and I think this is one of your most richly textured and at the same time one of the most accessible and enjoyable records so far: you all had a good time doing it, didn't you? Although it still has its melancholic moments...

(cg): "We enjoyed ourselves writing and rehearsing the songs and recording them. The mix was very difficult, because in the enjoyment of recording we had played a bit 'loose', so there were some mistakes and strange sounds on the tape which had to be mended or eliminated. It's accessible and enjoyable, surely, because the trilogy is about freedom: freedom of the body (sex-cd), of the mind (drugs-cd) and of the attitude or composure (R&R-cd). So Sex was very physical, Drugs very playful and R&R very direct and simple (what you will hear on it is what it is: naive but expressing true emotions)."

So: there's more to come. But for the time being: enjoy 'Drugs'. It's a mindgame you will surely want to play.
